## UPDATE 1-Enron makes \$4.68 bln in distributions

NEW YORK, April 3 (Reuters) - Fallen energy giant Enron Corp. on Monday said it made a distribution of \$4.68 billion to creditors as part of a regularly scheduled, twice-yearly payout following the company's bankruptcy.

In total, Enron said, it has returned \$5.83 billion to creditors since November 2004.

Enron said the most recent distribution, its ninth, consisted of about \$4.11 billion cash and \$568 million in Portland General Electric Co. stock.

The PGE stock represents about 43 percent of its issued and outstanding shares. Portland General plans to list this week on the New York Stock Exchange under the symbol "POR".

The rest of PGE's stock will go into a Disputed Claims Reserve for future distribution to Enron creditors.
