Warren woman to stand trial on embezzlement charges

WARREN -- A Warren woman accused of embezzling \$1.8 million while working as an office manager for an arthritis doctor will stand trial in Macomb Circuit Court.

Carol Salisbury, 59, was bound over Friday from 37th District Court on embezzlement and uttering and publishing charges.

Salisbury began working for Dr. Samir Yahia in October 1979 as office manager for the Detroit-based internist. Starting in 2003 and continuing through 2005, she is alleged to have taken checks issued to Yahia by insurance companies and Medicare and deposited them into her personal bank account, prosecutors said.

She is free on bond.
