### **Ex-County Worker Charged With Fraud**

A former employee for the Hillsborough County Tax Collector's Office has been charged with making \$25,000 by selling fraudulent driver licenses and altering immigration information, authorities said.

Deisy Oropesa, 30, a former senior customer service representative, admitted accepting \$200 per transaction for fraudulent licenses and altering the citizenship status of 58 people, according to a criminal arrest affidavit released Thursday by the Florida Highway Patrol.

Oropesa was charged with 174 counts of fraud, corruption and official misconduct by a public employee. She was being held Friday at the Hillsborough County jail on \$665,000 bail.
