Coosada woman gets 41 months in prison for embezzlement

MONTGOMERY, Ala. - A Coosada woman is headed to federal prison for embezzling three (m) million dollars from a Montgomery business that provided services to foster children.

The U.S. Attorney's Office, in a news release yesterday, said 57-year-old Linda Wade Dunn will serve 41 months in prison.

Dunn pleaded guilty June 19th to mail fraud and embezzlement for her role in a scheme to steal money from Therapeutic Programs Incorporated from June 1999 to February 2004.

U.S. District Judge William Watkins also ordered Dunn to pay more than two (m) million dollars in restitution.
