Hebron official admits to embezzlement

The former clerk and treasurer for the city of Hebron has pleaded guilty to embezzling more than \$46,000.

U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Ohio Gregory G. Lockhart said Wednesday that Vicky Fulk, who held the elected position since 1996, admitted she improperly credited herself with several thousand hours of sick and vacation leave before cashing in her accumulated off-time.

Fulk was not entitled to accrue sick or vacation leave. The attorney's office said Fulk manipulated the computer system from 2003 through May 2006.

She had been charged with one count of embezzlement from an organization receiving federal funds. The charge carries a maximum penalty of 10 years imprisonment and a \$250,000 fine. Fulk is free on bond and awaits sentencing.
